



Australian Racing & New Zealand B pools (thoroughbred/harness)

Wagering menu & rules

Current pools offered:

Win (first place finisher(s)) *\$1 minimum*

Place (first place and second place finisher(s) of race) *\$1 minimum**

***(NB For NZ racing the place pool pays to the first, second and third place finishers)**

Show (first place, second place, and third place finisher(s) of race) *\$1 minimum**

***(NB Show pool does not apply to NZ Racing)**

Exacta (first and second in exact order) *\$1 minimum*

Double (two consecutive first place finishers in programmed races) *\$1 minimum*

Trifecta (first, second, and third in exact order) *\$0.20 minimum*

Superfecta (first, second, third, and fourth in exact order) *\$0.20 minimum*

Pick 3 (first place finisher(s) in three consecutive races. Two per card R3-5, Last three races.) *\$0.20 minimum*

Pick 4 (first place finisher(s) in four consecutive races. One per card, last four races) *\$0.20 minimum*

Current wagering rules after early scratchings*: updated 7 February 2020

Win ≥ two runners

Exacta ≥ two runners

Double ≥ two runners

Place ≥ four runners

Trifecta ≥ four runners

Show ≥ six runners

Superfecta ≥ five runners

**all figures are at close of betting/number of horses that actually start the race. In the case of five runners*

actually jumping and only three finishing (two FTF), the superfecta would pay to First-Second-Third-ALL.

****With late scratchings after 'open,' pools are left in until the field drops under the amount of entries needed to complete the wager. For example, in a field of five with a late scratch down to four, the superfecta would stay in and pay to winners. If another horse comes out at the gate and only three start, the superfecta would then be refunded.****

No carryovers in place for any exotic (Ex,DD,Tri,Super,PK3,PK4) pools offered. In the event of no winning tickets,

entire pool after takeout goes to bettors with closest combination working backwards e.g. a trifecta with no

winning combinations would pay to all bettors with the first two placegetters and then

ALL in third, etc... 1-2-ALL, 1-ALL-ALL.

Current Pick Pool (PK3/PK4) rules with late withdrawals/surface change/leg loss:

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 and Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence:

A) winners of all legs

B) most winners, then refund (no winners of any leg or ALL-ALL-ALL).

If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.

In the event a Pick 3 or Pick 4 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3 or Pick 4, the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3 or Pick 4 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be

refunded if:

- Pick 3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled
- Pick 4: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled
